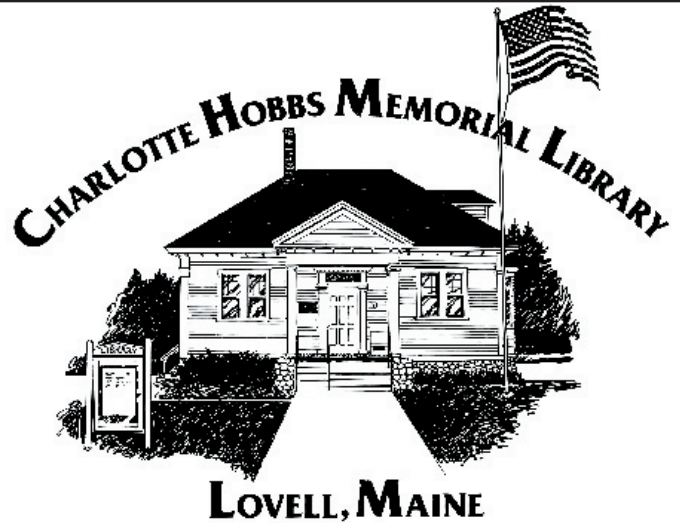

Dear Neighbors,

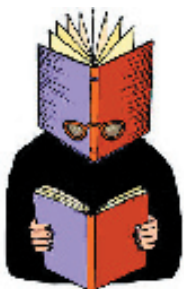

Happy spring and stay off the ice.

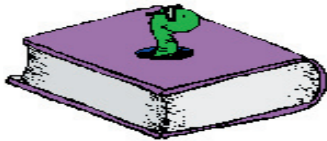
